## **Financial Update**

The total financial pledging for 2018 from our members came in at \$122,000 from 62 individual pledges. This compares with 2017's totals of \$139,000 from 72 pledges. While the average pledge for each year is nearly the same at roughly \$1900, the reduced number of pledges leaves the church facing a budget deficit of \$20,000 or more this year. Your vestry remains committed to minimizing expenses as much as possible; this situation, however, may very well wind up with the church being in the red for the year after 2 years of having small budget surpluses.
