

**A Word from Fr. Jim: "Prophetic"**

Last Sunday during my sermon I wondered aloud if there are times when God might be calling the Church, in the same manner that God has and does call individuals, to speak prophetically. Prophecy is not fortune-telling but rather truth-telling that is rooted in God's Commandments and the Gospel of Jesus Christ. It's a tricky business that often has to speak to power and against prevailing popular sentiments. This Sunday our lessons place before us Amos and John the Baptist, prophets of different times and circumstances. What might we hear and learn from their lives and willingness to answer God's call?



**The Patron Saint of our Parish is the Apostle James the Greater. We will observe the Feast Day of Saint James on Sunday, July 22nd.**

**Following the 9:30am service all are invited to join together for a picnic. Fried Chicken, sub sandwiches, and drinks will be provided. If you are able, you can bring a side dish, salad, or dessert.**

Two of the symbols used for Saint James the Apostle are a sword and a seashell. Last year people were invited to bring a seashell or two as we contemplated the various meanings of sea shells in Christian art, and their symbolism in terms of spiritual pilgrimages. This year we are being invited to come prepared on July 22<sup>nd</sup> to write down short answers to the follow three questions:

- 1) When it was that you first came to St. James Mill Creek?
- 2) Who brought you here and/or how did you find this parish?
- 3) Why did you stay?

You might think of these questions in terms of a pilgrimage: when did it begin, who were your traveling companions, and what did you find for yourself at the destination? So plan to come on July 22<sup>nd</sup> and share your journey with your fellow pilgrims.
