



A Word from Fr. Jim: "Nets"

When Jesus called his disciples, he found them sitting not in the synagogue, but at work. In Sunday's Gospel, he encountered some fishermen, including Peter, James, and John. These commercial fishermen used nets rather than hooks and lines, because a net can be cast over a broad area to catch a great number of fish at one time. Might the effectiveness of a net teach us something about how Jesus approached gathering people into the Kingdom of God?
