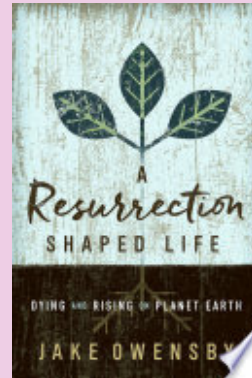

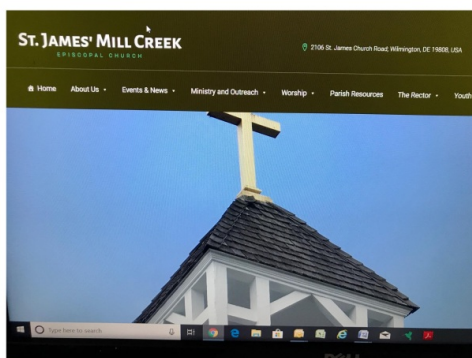

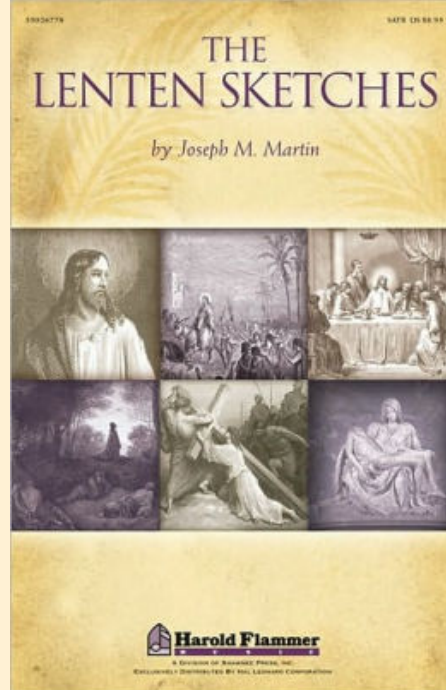


**Lenten Concert**
